# Planning and forecasting



## Auxiliary questions:

- What kind of preparedness cooperation is already being carried out to forecast the threat?
- How would forecasting be most effective?
- How should changes in the operating environment be taken into account in forecasting?
- How do you ensure that relevant lessons learned in the past (e.g. in exercises and real life) are taken into account in the forecasting of future threats?

# Operational picture



## Auxiliary questions:

- Who is first informed of the disruption?
- Who compiles the common operational picture?
- What kind of information is needed about the situation?
- How, with what and to whom is information shared?
- How is a shared understanding of the situation achieved?
- What challenges can you identify in the establishment of the common operational picture?



# Situation management and control



## Auxiliary questions:

- Who manages the situation, and how are responsibilities divided?
- What information do you need for making decisions?
- How does the situation impact your sector or organisation?
- How are the resources required in the situation coordinated?
- Have interdependencies between local actors been identified?
- What are the challenges associated with situation management and control?

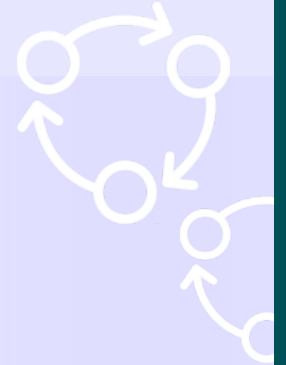




## Auxiliary questions:

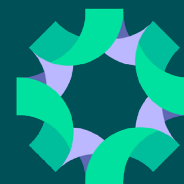
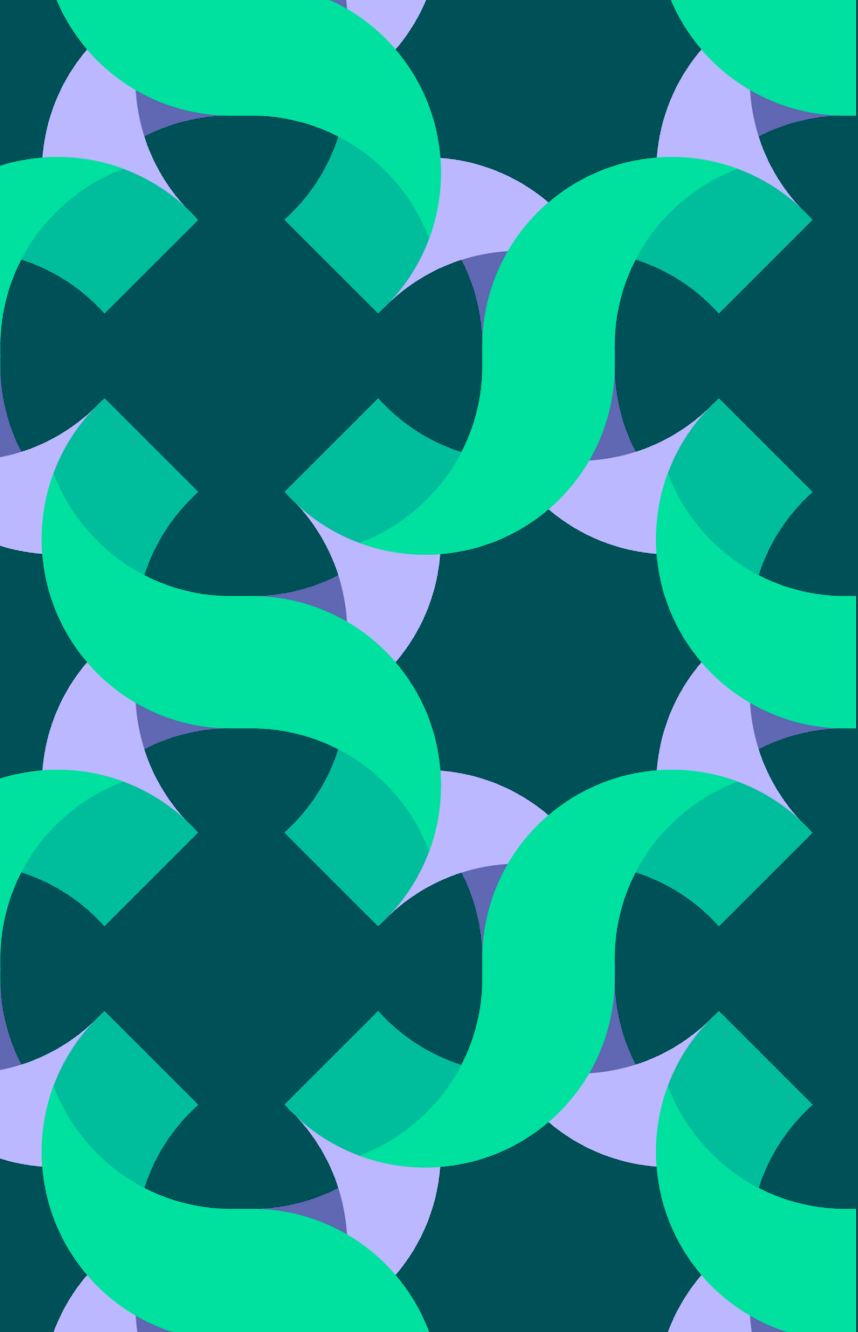
- How is information about the situation communicated?
- How are communications coordinated?
- Which communications channels do you use?
- What hinders consistent communications?
- How could you mitigate local communications challenges?
- How will you communicate after phones and the internet stop working?
- Who will be informed and how of the end of the situation?

# Recovery and assessment



## Auxiliary questions:

- How do you know that the emergency situation has ended?
- What do you need to take into account in recovery in terms of cooperation, customers and services?
- What challenges could you face in recovery?
- How is the situation jointly assessed?
- Can you identify an actor in the area who could take responsibility for the cooperation related to exercises focusing on this disruption?



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
